JOB DESCRIPTION

Title: Senior Park Aide
Reports to: Park Services Manager
Position Status: Part Time /Seasonal – nonexempt

JOB SUMMARY

Under general supervision, the Senior Park Aide performs a variety of duties related to general park maintenance and development of park and recreation areas and associated facilities. Work may involve basic janitorial responsibilities, maintenance and repair as well as involvement with construction of park areas and facilities.

EXAMPLES OF ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

1. Mow and maintain lawn area.
2. Install recreation equipment and play equipment.
3. Perform athletic field maintenance.
4. Clean park buildings and grounds.
5. Perform work relating to planting and care of trees, shrubs, flowers, and turf areas.
6. Assist with the installation, repair, and maintenance of irrigation systems.
7. Operate and maintain trucks, tractors, sprayers, chain saws and other power tools and hand tools.

ASSOCIATED JOB FUNCTIONS

- Perform other duties and responsibilities as assigned by supervisor.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Requires high school diploma, or equivalent experience and training.
- Requires a minimum of one year experience in park or public grounds maintenance or related field.
- Requires a valid Washington state driver's license.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- Ability to operate equipment in a responsible and safe manner
- Demonstrate a basic understanding of horticultural practices with an aptitude for ground work.
- Ability to work harmoniously in a group and to interact with the public in a positive and courteous manner.
- Demonstrated punctual and reliable in work habits.
- Willingness to accept supervision and to communicate effectively with supervisors.
- Ability to learn new job related skills as required.
- Can be trusted to work without direct supervision and take initiative where appropriate.
- Able to use time efficiently and effectively.

WORK ENVIRONMENT AND PHYSICAL EFFORT

Work may be performed outside in various parks under diverse weather conditions, as well as the maintenance shop, and office environments. May require occasional evening meetings and weekend duties. Must have the ability to perform duties that require sustained, strenuous physical exertion including activities such as moving and heavy lifting of items of up to 60 pounds, stacking, pushing,

pulling, bending, twisting, climbing, and standing for extended periods. Must have the ability to work at heights, and in dark conditions and noisy environments.
