

Outdoor Gear Rental Program

Bainbridge Island Metro Park & Recreation District has certain outdoor equipment that is available for community members to borrow for free. This free-to-use equipment exists to encourage more folks to get outdoors and try new activities without having to significantly invest to purchase personal gear.

Payment and eligibility:

- 1. BIMPRD does not charge for borrowing outdoor equipment. However, a \$15 deposit per item borrowed is required in the form of a check. The deposit is returning upon staff inspection of the borrowed gear to ensure it is clean, dry, properly packed, and undamaged.
- 2. Outdoor equipment is only available for participants enrolled in an Outdoor Programs trip or class. Exceptions may be made at the Outdoor Programs Coordinator's discretion.
- 3. Equipment can be reserved in person, via email, or over the phone during business hours with the Outdoor Programs Coordinator and is available on a first come, first serve basis.
- 4. It is the borrower's responsibility to check all equipment for damage or missing parts prior to leaving the office to ensure everything is in working order.

Returns:

- 1. Items are expected to be returned <u>CLEAN</u>, <u>DRY</u>, and <u>PROPERLY PACKED</u>. There is a \$15 per item charge for each item that we must clean, dry, or repack.
- 2. You are responsible for the full costs of repair or replacement if gear is damaged, lost, or stolen. Mildew destroys tents and affects future users. Make sure your tent is CLEAN & DRY!
- 3. BIMPRD reserves the right to refuse to lend equipment to participants in the future if they abuse equipment or violate the terms of this rental program.
- 4. BIMPRD will file a police report for stolen goods for equipment which is not returned and/or paid for by borrowers to seek compensation and/or return of the equipment.
