**CHANGE OF DATE FOR THIRD JONES & JONES PRESENTATION**

**ON SAKAI PARK SITE PLAN OPTIONS**

We want to inform you of a change in plans for the August 17, 2017 park board meeting. The third Jones & Jones presentation on site plan options for Sakai Park, originally scheduled for August 17, has been changed to September 21, 2017.

The August 17, 2017 park board meeting will now include a presentation by the Aquatic Design Group on the condition of the aging Ray Williamson Memorial Pool with options for approaching the pool's future.

As many of you are aware, the study of the Ray Williamson Pool has been underway this summer and the results will have an impact on what uses are decided upon for Sakai Park. The report is now finished and the findings are ready to be presented to the Park Board, the community, and Jones & Jones.

At the September 7, 2017 park board meeting, the Park Board will assess the island's aquatic needs in the context of what is possible at both the Aquatic Center and Sakai Park sites. A preferred aquatic alternative may be selected by the Park Board at this meeting, giving needed direction to Jones & Jones as they narrow down the feasible site plan options for Sakai Park.

At the September 21, 2107 park board meeting, Jones & Jones will make their third presentation on site plan options for Sakai Park.
