SAKAI PARK CONCEPT PLAN FEASIBILITY STUDY

The Board of Commissioners of the Bainbridge Island Metropolitan Park & Recreation District invites you to attend the June 6, 2019 board meeting at which time the feasibility study for the Sakai Park Concept Plan will be presented by architect/landscape architect Jones & Jones.

Following an extensive public process that began in 2016, the Sakai Park Concept Plan was adopted by the Board of Commissioners at the June 21, 2018 regular board meeting. A competitive RFQ (Request for Qualifications) process was then conducted. On October 4, 2018, the Park Board of Commissioners selected architect and landscape architect Jones & Jones to develop a feasibility study for the park plan.

The upcoming June 6 presentation of the feasibility study will include schematic designs for the facilities presented in the concept plan as well as estimated capital and operational costs. Board action is not anticipated. No decisions to move forward with the design or any aspect of it will be made at this meeting.
