Mitigation measures for Battle Point Park, Pickleball Court Construction SEPA Determination

This threshold determination is for six Pickleball Courts. A threshold determination under the State Environmental Policy Act in no way allows construction work to commence without appropriate construction permits, such as a building or grading permit. Mitigation measures become conditions of approval for the permit.

Mitigation measures to ensure no probable adverse environmental impact will occur during project construction:

- 1. An Inadvertent Discovery Plan (IDP) should be followed to provide for inadvertent archaeological discovery, including but not limited to, human remains and/or historic or prehistoric resources. Should artifacts be found, an immediate stop order will be implemented for assessment.
- 2. Any disturbed areas for the installation of the courts shall be replanted with appropriate park plantings prior to the final inspection.
- 3. All provisions for Stormwater Management will be implemented as provided by Cobi review and permitting.
