



THE COVID COLORING BOOK CHALLENGE 2020

COMPOSITION

THINK ABOUT YOUR COMPOSITION:

- How are you going to fill the entire page (picture plane)?
- What makes a good composition?

ZOOM IN:

- Get closer to your subject than you might think to do.
- Look at less things, but look at them closely. This is better than including a lot of visual information without much attention.

RULE OF THIRDS:

- Don't put your subject smack in the middle of the paper!
- Horizontal: put the horizon line at the top or bottom third.
- Vertical: put the primary subject at the left or right third.

WHAT IS A VIEWFINDER?

- Usually made of two L-shaped $\frac{1}{2}$ frames that, once put together and held in the air in front of a subject, and defines the area of the subject that will be included the composition.

HOW TO USE A VIEWFINDER?

- Before you start, use the viewfinder to capture exactly how what you are looking at is going to fit on the paper.

OR

- After you finish drawing, use a viewfinder to find the most interesting composition.
