



Strawberry Hill Park Concept Plan — Addendum, Questions, and Answers

1. What is the anticipated level of completion for park drawings? Will there be any regulatory submittals?

The park drawings are intended to be conceptual drawings with no regulatory submittals expected.

2. What other concurrent design/redesign processes will the consultant team be expected to coordinate with, and to what level?

There are current plans underway, utilizing citizen user committees, for an expanded footprint of the skate park, an expanded footprint of the dog park, and a new bike park designed in the latest section of the park. The successful consultant will incorporate those planning efforts into the entire site concept plan. All other proposed or planned site activities will be part of this planning effort.

3. There are two dates given for when qualifications are due – 5/12 and 5/15. Can you confirm which date is the due date?

5/15 is the due date.

4. Who are the members of the evaluation committee? And will there be any weighting for committee members voting?

Typically, key Park District staff involved in the project are the interview team; this does not preclude a couple of other stakeholder representatives if the Park District deems it desirable.

5. What will the Phase 2 present proposal to the evaluation committee format be? In-person or virtual?

Phase 3 is the “presentations/interview” segment. Interviews are at the Park District’s discretion; a decision on this will be made once the submission phase has occurred and the Technical Proposal phase has been evaluated from the submissions received.
