An energetic person with a playful personality must teach recreational classes and competitive team-level gymnasts. Must have coaching experience with USAG boys JD or girls JD compulsory and/or Xcel, and be able to work with ages 2 & up; excellent public relations and communication skills for administrative and clerical duties; basic computer skills; be available to workdays, evenings, and weekends.

Qualifications: Available daytime, evenings, and weekends
Gymnastics and/or dance experience (training is available)
Experience teaching adults and youth
Lesson planning for recreational classes and competitive teams

Wage: 12-step salary scale: \$27.17 to \$37.62 per hour. Starting wage DOE.
