**Duties:** Under general supervision of the SCoCo Coordinator, performs a variety of duties related to invasive species removal and restoration of park areas with a group of 18-24 peers. Work may involve physical fieldwork, removing ivy, scotch broom, and other invasive plants from local parks, including Blakely Harbor Park, Fort Ward Park, Gazzam Lake Nature Preserve, and Pritchard Park. May act as lead over small groups of peers as needed.

SCoCo members will need to show commitment, enthusiasm, and the capacity to work well as team members to engage fully in this program.

**Wage:** 12-step salary scale: \$21.00 to \$29.07 per hour. Starting wage DOE.
